

PROMOTE THE ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, "There seems to be a tendency of leaders and followers to withdraw from organizations which they once regarded as mutual interest--each group to formulate policies and platforms affecting children and youth, without mutual consultation and coordination,"; and

WHEREAS, A house divided is in danger of collapse, affecting the home, the school, the church and the community adversely; and

WHEREAS, The PTA goals and objects are as appropriate today as when they were written, and the organization more responsive to the needs of the children and youth than most other parent and community groups organized with specific or ulterior motive; and

WHEREAS, Without PTA, the average child would have no organized effort in his behalf; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That PTA leaders promote an allegiance to the PTA organization at all levels of service with full recognition that united we stand and divided we fail the children and youth whose advocate we are, and whose welfare we promote; and be it further

Resolved, That this allegiance recognize the service and value of National, State, Council and Local Unit which constitute the PTA organization.
