

CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH DISABILITIES, BIRTH THROUGH FIVE

WHEREAS, Utah PTA is supportive of a program providing services and education for children with disabilities from birth through five; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Regulations Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 provides for education to preschool children with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, The state of Utah is now providing services and education to children who are deaf and blind from birth through five; and

WHEREAS, The Governor's Advisory Council for the Developmentally Disabled is proposing legislation aimed at programs and services for children with disabilities ages birth through five; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That Utah PTA and its constituent bodies encourage better coordination of all services for handicapped pedestrian hazards on state highways; and be it further

Resolved, That Utah PTA and its constituent bodies support the establishment of a risk register so that those children born with a high risk for developing disabilities will be given appropriate services from birth; and be it further

Resolved, That Utah PTA support and monitor those agencies responsible for providing services to children with disabilities from birth through five.
