AVAILABILITY AND ACCESSIBILITY OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RESOLUTION

WHEREAS,	The Utah PTA has demonstrated its support of legislation regulating and controlling the sale of alcoholic beverages in the state; and
WHEREAS,	The state of Utah extensively promotes programs aimed at discouraging drinking and driving; and
WHEREAS,	The proliferation of drive-up windows has increased the accessibility of alcoholic beverages (beer) to the public in general and minors specifically; and
WHEREAS,	Minors may be more likely to attempt a purchase of beer from the darkened security of a vehicle; and
WHEREAS,	Drinking and driving is encouraged and promoted by the sale of alcoholic beverages from drive-up windows; and
WHEREAS,	It is difficult for police to supervise places where beer is dispensed through drive-up windows; now, therefore, be it
Resolved,	That Utah PTA urge passage of legislation banning the sale of alcoholic beverages through drive-up windows; and be it further
Resolved,	That Utah State PTA create an awareness of the hazards of selling alcoholic beverages not within the dispensing store where proper I.D. can be closely checked.
