PURPOSE: The primary purpose of the Refugee Center is to foster opportunities for refugees to access better paying jobs. The Office of Refugee Resettlement reports that the average wage for refugees in Utah is \$8.25 per hour—not enough to become self-sufficient and support a family.

FOCUS AREA: Programming at the Center serves as a bridge to help refugees access higher education and training programs needed for better paying jobs. The Center also serves as a gathering place for refugee community groups to hold meetings to build stronger and more integrated communities.

PARTNERSHIP: The partnership between Salt Lake Community College, Utah State University and Workforce Services facilitates employment training and access to academic achievement — making a real difference by helping families reach a sustainable wage.
