AREA DIRECTORS (4 POSITIONS)

Qualifications:

- Be a current member of PTA.
- It is preferred to have previously served at least one term as a Utah PTA Region Support Committee Chair.
- It is strongly recommended to have served one term as a local or council PTA president or board member.
- Have a knowledge and understanding of PTA programs.
- Be familiar with and knowledgeable about education and legislative issues.
- Have a working knowledge of parliamentary procedure (use Robert's Rules of Order), the bylaws, and standing rules.

Job Description:

- 1. Know and support the mission of Utah PTA.
- 2. Utilize and update position procedure book and other materials and be ready to pass onto successor.
- Review and update website pages related to this position on a regular basis.
- 4. Serve as a member of both the Utah PTA Board of Directors and Board of Managers.
- Serve as a member of the Area Support Committee and an aide to the Area Vice President.
- 6. Identify training needs and forward to the Leadership Committee for creation of materials.
- 7. Within assigned area:
 - Act as a liaison between Utah PTA and region support committees and facilitate training for region support committees.
 - Identify annually, PTAs/PTSAs that qualify for dissolution and the process according to the dissolution checklist/packet.
 - Identify annually, any schools that could be potential PTAs/PTSAs and start the new PTA process.
- 8. Serve as a member of one standing committee and one working committee of Utah PTA beyond the Area Support Committee.
- Complete assignments from the Board of Directors.
