Qualifications:

- Be a current member of PTA.
- It is preferred to have previously served at least one year on a Utah PTA Commission or Committee.
- It is preferred to have served one term on a local or council PTA board.
- Have a working knowledge of Technology tools and solutions.
- Have a knowledge and understanding of PTA programs.
- Have a working knowledge of parliamentary procedure (use Robert's Rules of Order), the bylaws, and standing rules.

Job Description:

- 1. Know and support the mission of Utah PTA.
- 2. Utilize and update position procedure book and other materials and be ready to pass onto successor.
- 3. Review and update website pages related to this position on a regular basis.
- 4. Serve as a member of the Utah PTA Board of Managers under the direction of the President.
- 5. Organize and chair the Technology Committee.
- 6. Oversee subordinate committees which include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Givebacks
- 7. With the help of the Technology Committee, coordinate and recommend technology solutions as needed for events and programs.
- 8. Coordinate with the Director of Leadership and Utah PTA staff to support the Board of Directors and Board of Managers with website updates.
- 9. With the help of the Technology Committee, coordinate technology training as needed by members of the board of managers and locals and council units.
- 10. Serve as a member on committees of community organizations as requested and by approval of the Utah PTA president.
