

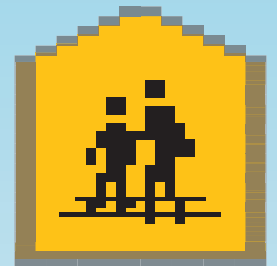

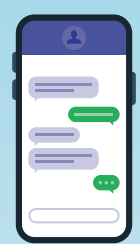

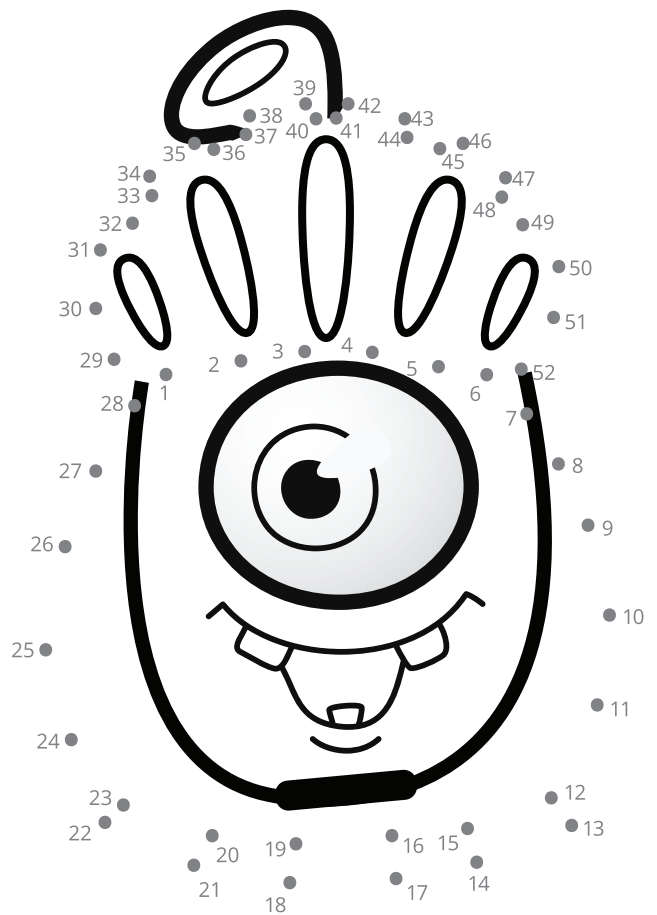

# Safe Route ADVENTURE

Walking to school can be an adventure, especially if you know the rules of the road and follow your Safe Routes Map (which you can get from your principal).

## Map Key:



**First:**  
Color the house green.



**Second:**  
Color the school blue.



**Third:**  
Color all stop signs on the map red.



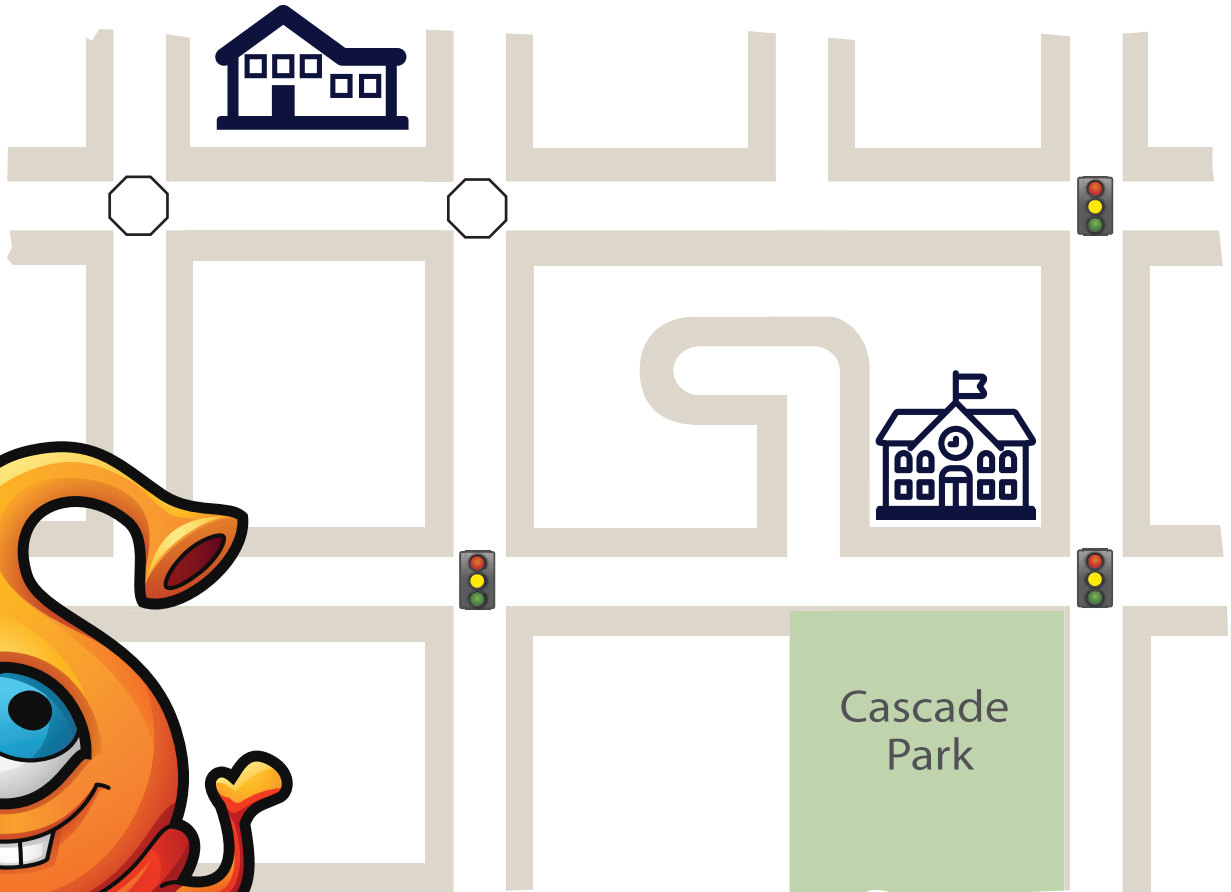
**Fourth:**  
Circle all of the traffic lights where you need to wait to cross until you see a pedestrian crossing signal.



**Fifth:**  
Draw crosswalks to help you safely cross the street to get to school.



**Sixth:**
